As we conclude another impactful year, I am deeply grateful for your unwavering support and generosity. With **£3,928,46.22** raised, we've been able to:

- Provide vital resources to widows and their families
- Offer education to underprivileged children
- Deliver clean water to remote villages
- Rebuild houses and mosques damaged by the 2022 floods

In Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, where many continue to face the aftermath of the floods, we've reached rural communities to repair damaged infrastructure and support daily life with essentials.

Our **Empowering Communities project** saw significant growth this year, with a 20% increase in the distribution of food carts, sewing machines, and wheelchairs.

Healthcare remains a priority, and the Captain Muazzam Ali Shaheed Welfare Trust Hospital has expanded its free medical card programme from 4,000 to 6,000 patients, helping more families access essential services. We're also planning to extend the hospital building to meet growing needs.

As we look to the future, we are motivated by the opportunities ahead to impact even more rural areas in Pakistan.

Together, we are making a difference.

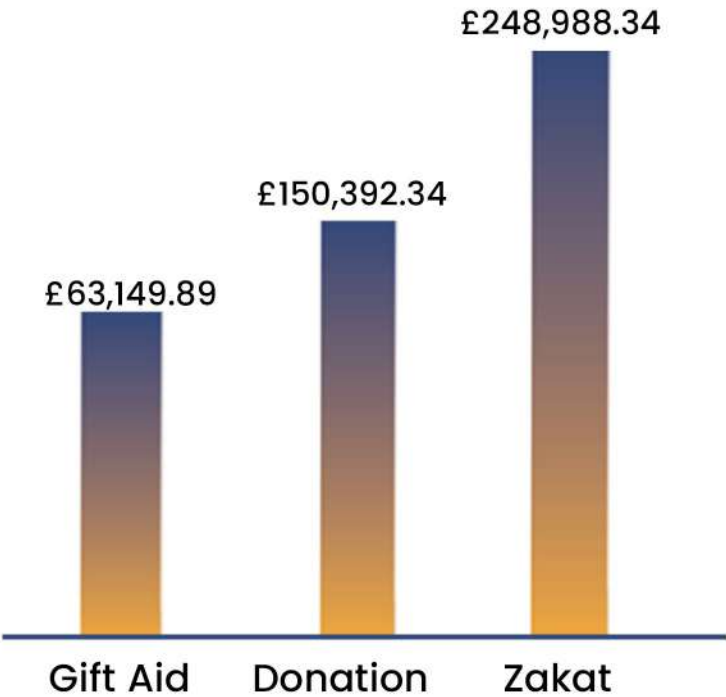

Cataracts remain a major health challenge in Pakistan, leading to vision impairment and blindness—particularly among individuals from low-income communities who cannot afford treatment.

To help address this critical need, the Muazzam Foundation organized its 8th Annual Free Eye Camp on 2nd and 3rd November 2024 at Muazzam Hospital, Jhelum.



Supported by a team of expert eye specialists from Al-Shifa Eye Trust Hospital, Rawalpindi, the camp restored sight and independence to many, alleviating a critical need for the community.

For the upcoming year, the goal is to conduct an additional 200+ cataract operations, further expanding the reach and effectiveness of this vital service.

At **Captain Muazzam Ali Shaheed Welfare Hospital**, we are dedicated to ensuring every patient receives the care they deserve. When specialized treatment is required, we refer them to external hospitals and cover all associated costs — because every life matters.

Usman Case Study:

Usman, the young son of a poor daily wage labourer, was born with a hole in his heart and needed urgent surgery his family couldn't afford. Through the Muazzam Foundation's Medical Support Program and generous donor support, his operation was successfully carried out. Alhamdulillah, Usman is now healthy, happy, and living a normal life — a true example of how compassion and collective effort can save lives.

Khadeja Case Study:

A 21-day-old baby girl was diagnosed with a membrane in her brain and a spinal cord tumor (rasoli), leaving her in an extremely critical condition. Her parents, unable to afford the doctor's fees, medical stents, and essential treatment supplies, turned to Muazzam Foundation for help. Through the generosity of donors, her life-saving surgery was arranged in time. Alhamdulillah, she is now recovering and showing signs of improvement — a true testament to how collective compassion can save even the most fragile lives.

Access to clean and safe water is a fundamental human right, yet many communities across Pakistan continue to suffer from severe water scarcity and poor sanitation. In Sindh, contaminated water sources have led to widespread illnesses such as cholera, dysentery, and hepatitis, with children and the elderly being the most vulnerable.

The Muazzam Foundation is addressing these challenges with sustainable solutions to improve access to clean water and sanitation facilities.

These efforts not only meet immediate water needs but also build a foundation for better health, economic growth, and well-being in vulnerable communities. With your support, we have significantly reduced waterborne diseases, improved public health, and enhanced food safety and hygiene standards.

In Parachinar, a remote mountainous region of Pakistan, communities face immense challenges in accessing clean water due to geographic isolation and the absence of basic infrastructure. Many families are forced to walk nearly a mile—often with donkeys—to fetch water from distant sources that are frequently contaminated and insufficient to meet their daily needs. This ongoing hardship affects health, livelihoods, and the overall well-being of the community.

Through its dedicated Food Projects, the Muazzam Foundation strives to meet the nutritional needs of vulnerable communities, ensuring that struggling families receive not only sustenance but also care, dignity, and support in their time of need.

As part of our commitment to holistic patient care, we provide freshly prepared hot meals to all admitted patients at Muazzam Hospital. These nutritious meals are tailored to support recovery and well-being, ensuring that patients receive not only medical treatment but also the nourishment they need to heal with dignity and comfort.





Qurbani

Food insecurity continues to be a major challenge across Pakistan and India, leaving countless families without access to nutritious meals. During **Eid-ul-Adha**, the **Muazzam Foundation** performed Qurbani on behalf of generous donors, ensuring that vulnerable families received fresh, wholesome meat and shared in the joy and blessings of this sacred occasion.

Food insecurity remains a critical challenge across Pakistan and India, leaving thousands of families without access to basic nutrition. In response, during Eid-ul-Adha, the Muazzam Foundation carried out Qurbani on behalf of compassionate donors—bringing fresh, high-quality meat to vulnerable families who would otherwise go without.



Through this initiative, over **1,400** individuals were reached with nutritious Qurbani meat, offering not only food, but also hope, dignity, and the spirit of Eid. A total of:

- **5 full cows**
- **5 shares in large animals**
- **3 small animals**

were sacrificed in strict accordance with Islamic principles, ensuring the highest standards of hygiene and religious compliance.

With **£3,130.00 allocated**, the Muazzam Foundation distributed this meat to some of the most deprived communities across Pakistan and India—those with limited or no access to regular meals. This effort brought smiles, nourishment, and the joy of Eid to hundreds of homes.

Unfortunately, many communities across Pakistan lack access to proper masjids, with some relying on damaged or neglected structures. This not only limits opportunities for worship and learning but also weakens the bonds of unity and belonging, highlighting the urgent need to build and restore these sacred spaces.

The Muazzam Foundation is committed to meeting this vital need by constructing new masjids and restoring those that have fallen into neglect. In 2024–25, the Foundation built 7 new masjids and renovated several others, bringing renewed hope, spiritual strength, and a sense of unity to underserved and remote communities across Pakistan.

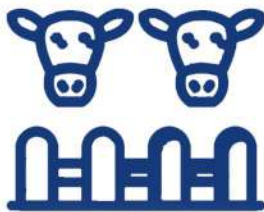

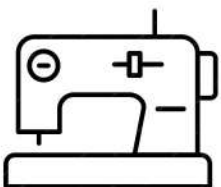

For many struggling families, financial hardships make it impossible to afford essentials like uniforms, textbooks, and transportation — forcing them to prioritize daily survival over their children's education.

Recognizing the transformative power of education, the Muazzam Foundation is dedicated to breaking these barriers by providing focused financial assistance and essential learning resources to those in need.

In February 2025, the school opened its doors, bringing hope and opportunity to children eager to learn but limited by financial hardships. Providing free, quality education — including uniforms, books, and tuition — the school ensures that no child is left behind due to lack of resources. Alhamdulillah, within just three months, over 200 students have been enrolled, reflecting the community's trust and the urgent need for such support.



Al-Qasim Institute (Special Needs Education)

Funds Allocated: **£1,432.91**

The Al-Qasim Institute in Jhelum stands as a beacon of hope for children with special needs, providing a nurturing and inclusive environment that supports their learning, growth, and holistic development.



25 Sponsored Students: Comprehensive care included education, uniforms, and specialised therapies such as physical, occupational, and speech therapy to meet their unique needs.



Teacher Salaries: 10% of monthly salaries (Rs 20,560) Customized programs tailored to each student's needs for an effective learning experience.



In June 2024, our students proudly represented Pakistan at the Special Olympics in Berlin, winning gold, silver, and bronze medals. In 2025, two talented girls continued this legacy, winning titles at the Olympic and District Games, proving that with support, every child can shine.

This initiative underscores the vital importance of inclusive education, empowering children with special needs to realize their full potential and thrive in both local and global communities.



Multi Skill Hub Centre

Total Donated Funds:

£48,282.35

In Pakistan, widespread poverty and economic challenges have severely limited access to quality education and vocational training, leaving many individuals without the skills needed for stable employment. Recognising this pressing need, the Muazzam Foundation established the Multi Skill Hub Centre on August 14, 2023, with the mission to empower communities through practical skill development and sustainable livelihood opportunities.

The centre offers a diverse range of courses to enhance their livelihood opportunities:



Digital Skills: Amazon Virtual Assistant, Graphic Design, Digital Marketing, Freelancing, Videography & Video Editing Jhelum.



Technical Skills: Mobile Repairing, Electrician, Electronics Technician



Language Skills: IELTS and Spoken English



Welfare Training: Welfare Academy



The Multi Skill Hub Centre ensures affordability and accessibility by offering courses at greatly reduced fees. Through its Welfare Academy, students can access all subjects for just Rs. 500, making quality education attainable for even the most disadvantaged.

IT Centre

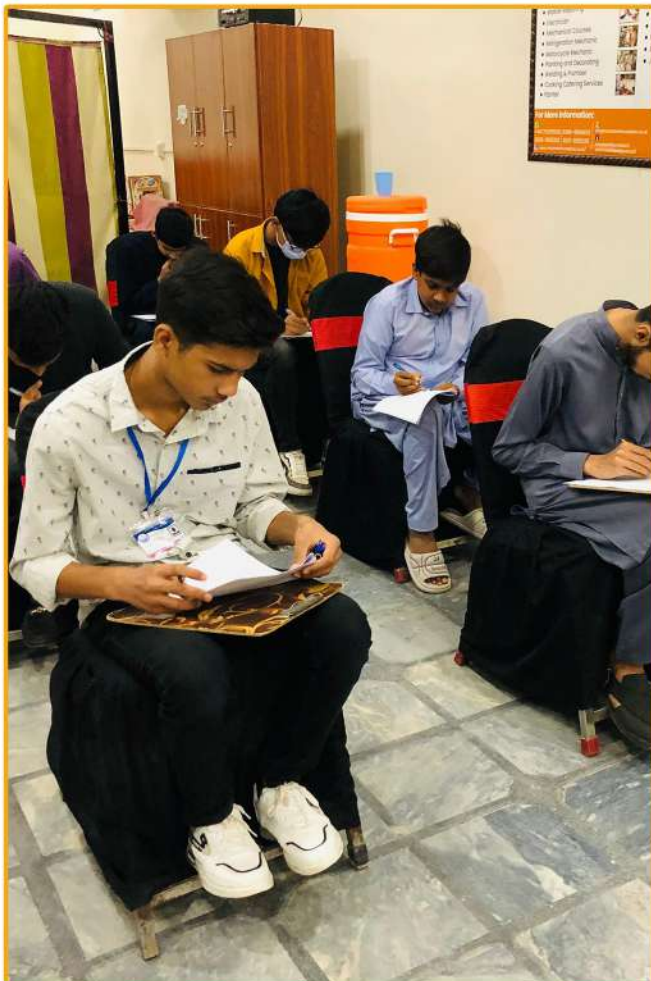

The Al-Zohra Sadiq Vocational Institute in Jhelum is dedicated to empowering women and widows through free vocational training, equipping them with practical skills that pave the way toward financial independence and self-reliance. By gaining meaningful employment or launching small businesses, many graduates become primary earners, contributing halal income and transforming the futures of their families with dignity and hope.

70+ Students Trained Women and widows completed courses in:

- Sewing, knitting, cutting and designing
- Jewellery making
- Cooking
- Computer skills

60–80 graduates received tools and support to launch their own businesses, including:

Qur'an & Islamic Book Distribution

Funds Allocated: £1515

In 2024–25, the Muazzam Foundation made a meaningful contribution to promoting Islamic education and spiritual growth by distributing Qurans and Islamic books across various educational institutions. Alhamdulillah, over 250 copies of the Holy Quran and other valuable Islamic texts were provided to Jamia Ayesha Sadiqa and Madrasa Bilal Town, Jhelum, enriching students' knowledge and fostering a deeper connection with their faith.

The Qur'ans and books enriched the curriculum, providing students and staff with invaluable resources to deepen their understanding of Islamic principles, history, and teachings.



Uniform Distribution

Funds Allocated: £1,800

The cost of school uniforms often prevents families from sending their children to school. To ease this burden and promote access to education, the Foundation distributed over 780 school uniforms to students in underserved communities, including:

- Govt Boys & Girls High School, Jhelum
- Govt Boys & Girls High School, Kashmir Colony
- Govt High School, Garmala, Jhelum

By easing this financial burden, the Foundation enabled more children to attend school with dignity, confidence, and a renewed commitment to their education.



Winter Pack

Funds Allocated: £3,124.23

Through the Winter Pack Project 2025, Muazzam Foundation distributed warm clothes, blankets, jackets, shoes, and essential items to deserving families, children, and the elderly across Punjab, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, and Sindh. This initiative aims to protect vulnerable communities from the harsh winter, spreading warmth, compassion, and hope — one family at a time.

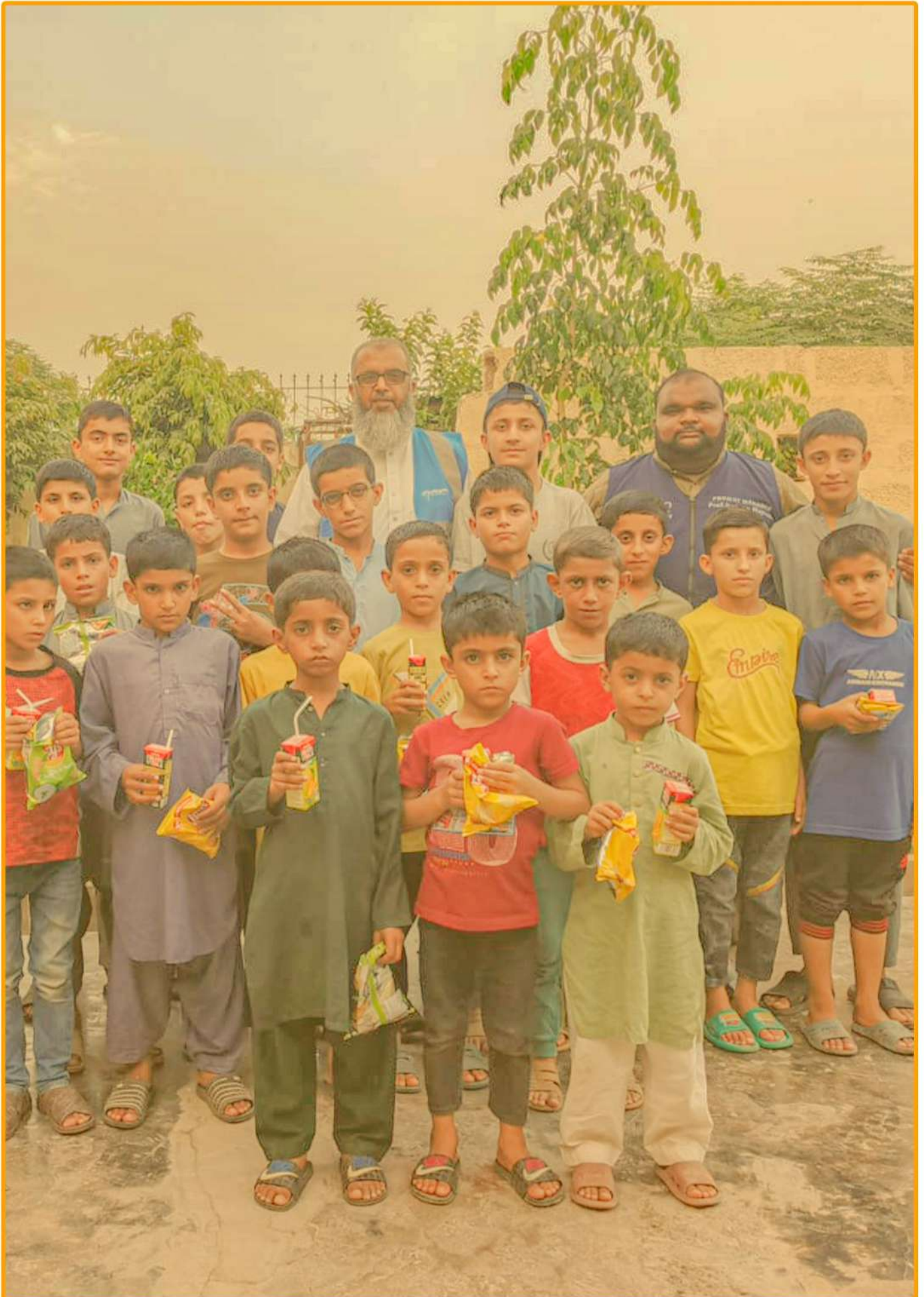
